SAMPLE ITINERARY

*Our pilgrimage coincides with the annual **International Military Pilgrimage (May 22-24)**, one of the most festive times in the Lourdes season. This pilgrimage is renowned for its music festival on Saturday afternoon, played by multiple brass bands. The pilgrimage also brings with it a wide range of colourful uniforms, insignia and banners, including those of the Vatican Swiss Guards and the white berets of the Alpine hunters. The candlelight procession and other ceremonies will take on an ever more joyous character with the presence of these colourful bands.*

Day One, Friday May 22nd

Arrival

Flight with Aer Lingus from Dublin to Toulouse. Coach transfer to three-star hotel in Lourdes, where we will stay five nights on a full-board basis. Our programme today depends on flight times (which will be confirmed later). Dinner. The candlelight procession begins at 9pm.

Day Two, Saturday May 23rd

Events of the International Pilgrimage, Mass

Our programme today will be tailored to fit in with the festive events of the International Military pilgrimage. Mass celebration. Lunch and dinner included in the hotel.

Day Three, Sunday May 24th

Walking tour of Lourdes

Breakfast. Mass. Lunch in the hotel. In the afternoon, we will have a walking tour of town, including the cemetery where the Soubirous family is buried, the Boly Mill (birthplace of St. Bernadette, whose father was a miller) and the *Cachot*, an abandoned prison where the family was living at the time of the apparitions. Dinner at the hotel. After dinner, there will again be the opportunity to participate in the candlelight procession.

Day Four, Monday May 25th

Bartres, Stations of the Cross

After breakfast, coach excursion to Bartres, the little village outside Lourdes where Bernadette spent some of her childhood. Mass in the parish church of St John the Baptist and blessing with a first-class relic of St Bernadette. Return to hotel for lunch. Stations of the Cross will be organised in the mid-afternoon. Dinner at the hotel. Candlelight procession at 9pm.

Day Five, Tuesday May 26th

Mass, Baths, Eucharistic Procession

After breakfast, Mass celebration in the sanctuary. This morning, there will be an opportunity to visit the baths. Queuing is usually necessary. The water flows from the spring unearthed by Bernadette at Our Lady's command. Countless healings, both physical and spiritual, have occurred here. Lunch in the hotel. At 5pm every day there is a Eucharistic procession which finishes with Benediction in the underground basilica. Dinner. Candlelight procession at 9pm.

Day Six, Wednesday May 27th

Departure

Breakfast and check-out. Flight to Dublin from Toulouse airport. Exact flight times to be confirmed later.
