Ryanair flight to Venice. One hour transfer to 4-star spa resort hotel in Abano Terme near Padua, where we will stay for seven nights half board.

Day Three, Friday

After breakfast we will go by coach to the port and take a boat to the picturesque island of Burano. This is the most colourful island in the Venetian lagoon and is famous for lace making. After our tour, free time for lunch and shopping. Return to the hotel in the mid-afternoon. Dinner.

Day Four, Saturday

Treviso, Free afternoon After breakfast, we will go by coach to Treviso. This medieval city has beautiful palaces and squares and many historical churches. After our tour, some free time for lunch. Return to Abano Terme. Free afternoon to enjoy the hotel pool and shops. Dinner.

Day Five, Sunday

Padua is one of the most important pilgrimage destinations in Italy. Millions of pilgrims every year make their way to St Anthony's Basilica, where the Franciscan saint, St. Anthony from Lisbon, is buried. Relics include the tongue of the saint, symbol of his outstanding preaching skills. In the morning, we will have a tour of the Basilica and visit the Chapel of the Relics. People will have time to attend one of the Sunday Masses. Dinner at the hotel.

Day Six, Monday

Venice, St Mark's Rialto Bridge Day trip to the city of Venice. Our tour will include the Bridge of Sighs, Rialto Bridge, St Mark's Square and Basilica. The Basilica contains the body of St Mark the Evangelist, taken here by Venetian merchants in the 9th century. Afternoon free for shopping and sightseeing. Optional gondola rides will be organised. In the evening, we will take the boat to the mainland. Return to Abano. Dinner at the hotel.
