

SAMPLE ITINERARY

Day One, Wednesday 31st May

Arrival in Nice

Check in at Dublin airport at 8.30am for our 11.30am Aer Lingus flight to Nice airport. On arrival, we will be taken by coach to our four-star hotel in Sanremo, Italy. Check-in. Free time, followed by an orientation tour on foot of the city centre. Dinner at the hotel and overnight.

Day Two, Thursday 1st June

Sanremo

Today we will have a relaxing day visiting the principal sights of Sanremo, including the ancient basilica of San Siro and some of the many historic villas that are located in the historic centre. Via Giacomo Matteotti is the main street of the city and is lined with shops, cafes and restaurants. Free afternoon. Dinner at the hotel.

Day Three, Friday 2nd June

Genoa

After breakfast we will drive to Genoa, once the capital of a powerful maritime republic for many centuries. Birthplace of Christopher Columbus, the city has stunning architecture, medieval gates, elegant palaces, and a dense system of ancient streets. The 12th century Cathedral of San Lorenzo has a splendid entrance portal. We will see the hotel Feder where Daniel O'Connell died in May 1847. Free time for lunch and personal exploration of the city. Return to Sanremo for dinner.

Day Four, Saturday 3rd June

Day at leisure

Today we will have a relaxing day and a chance to visit some of the remaining sights in Sanremo. Dinner and overnight.

Day Five, Sunday 4th June

Monaco and Nice

Coach trip after breakfast to Monaco (1 hour drive). Our visit will include the cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Monaco-Ville where Grace Kelly is buried, the Prince's Palace and Salle Garnier (opera house of Monte Carlo), and other sights. After lunch, we will continue to Nice, one of the most-visited cities in France. Once the winter resort of European aristocracy, it is a very multi-cultural place. The Promenade des Anglais ("Promenade of the English") lies along the Bay of the Angels, an area inhabited by wealthy English people in the 18th century. We will visit the Cathedral of Nice, originally consecrated in the 11th century and rebuilt in the 1600s. The enormous Place Masséna is the main square of the city and is surrounded by beautiful buildings. Return to Sanremo in time for dinner.

Day Six, Monday 5th June

Day at leisure

Day at leisure in Sanremo.

Day Seven, Tuesday 6th June

Turin

Coach trip to Turin (over 3 hours). Turin was the capital of the kingdom of Piedmont and the seat of the Savoy dynasty who eventually became monarchs of Italy. It is a majestic city, studded with monuments and historic buildings. We will visit the Cathedral, home to the world-famous Shroud of Turin. The shroud is kept in a special case in a side chapel, but is only displayed on rare occasions. We will be permitted to kneel and spend time in front of this container. We will also visit Valdocco, the home of the Salesian order and the burial place of Don Bosco. Return to Sanremo for a later than usual dinner.

Day Eight, Wednesday 7th June

Departure

Breakfast and check out. Departure for Nice Airport at 11am. Check in at 12.50pm for our 3.50pm flight to Dublin. Arrival in Dublin at 4.35pm local time.
