Day One, Tuesday

Arrival in Rome

Check-in at Dublin Airport for our afternoon flight to Rome. On arrival you will be taken by coach to our 3-star hotel in Rome city centre. Check-in and free time for dinner in the area of the hotel.

Day Two, Wednesday

Some highlights of Rome

After breakfast we will visit some of the sights of Rome, including a number of basilicas and baroque squares. Given that out time in Rome is short, we wish to avoid places that involve long queues. As the time of travel approaches, today's itinerary and venue for Mass will be worked out in detail. In the evening we will have a night coach-tour which will include some of the most famous landmarks of Rome, such as the Colosseum, Tiber Island and the Ghetto, St Mary Major and St John Lateran, the Holy Stairs and much more. Free time for dinner.

Day Three, Thursday

Departure from Rome, Arrival in Assisi

After breakfast we will check-out of hotel and load the coach. We will proceed to our three-star hotel in the town just below Assisi, not far from the Basilica of Santa Maria degli Angeli. Inside the basilica is located the little chapel of the "Porziuncola". This was the first permanent home of the Franciscans and the place where St Francis died. After checking in at the hotel and a little rest, we will have a walking tour of the area followed by Mass in the nearby Basilica. Dinner at the hotel. Excursion to the high part of Assisi after dinner.

Day Four, Friday

Full day in Assisi, Basilica of St Francis, Basilica of St Clare, Blessed Carlo Acutis

Full day in Assisi. Assisi is renowned as the birthplace of Saint Francis and St Clare. The Basilica of St Francis houses the saint's' tomb and is adorned by the frescoes of Giotto. We will also visit the Basilica of St Clare, and the church of St Mary Major with the body of Blessed Carlo Acutis. Mass will be celebrated in this church, which is also the place where St Francis renounced his father's inheritance and began living by the providence of his heavenly Father. Back to our hotel for dinner.

Day Five, Saturday

After breakfast we will visit one of the best-known Italian towns in Umbria, Spoleto. Once a Roman town, it has many archaeological remains. The Cathedral of Spoleto is a wonderful example of Romanesque architecture. Fresco masterpieces by Filippo Lippi (late 1400s) on the life of the Virgin Mary adorn the central apse. Mass in the Cathedral. Return to Assisi in the early afternoon. Dinner at the hotel.

Day Six, Sunday Cascia

This morning, after breakfast we will board our coach for Cascia. Here we will visit the tomb and monastery of St Rita. St Rita was a wife and mother before entering the Augustinian convent. Her beautiful shrine is one of the most popular in central Italy. Mass. Free time for lunch. Return to Assisi. Dinner.

Day Seven, Monday

Day at leisure

Day at leisure. There is a weekly market in Santa Maria degli Angeli every Monday. Excursion to the high part of Assisi after dinner.

Day Eight, Tuesday

Departure

After breakfast we will check out of our hotel, load our coach and make our way to Orvieto. Orvieto is famous for the Eucharistic Miracle that prompted the Pope to introduce the feast of Corpus Christi. The relics of the miracle are conserved in a splendidly frescoed chapel of Orvieto Cathedral. Mass. Free time for lunch. We will then board our coach again and head to Rome airport for our evening flight.
