Arrival in Italy

Mid-day flight to Venice from Dublin. On arrival gather with Kieran and Fr Celsus who will take you to our private coach for our short transfer to our 4-star hotel in Lido di Jesolo. Here we will stay for six nights on a half-board. Check-in. Rest. Dinner at the hotel.

Day Two, Thursday

Free day

Our hotel is seafront near the centre of the shopping area. It has a swimming pool and private beach. Breakfast at leisure. Orientation tour. Mass will be organised in the local parish church in the late afternoon. Dinner in the hotel.

Day Three, Friday

Venice, St Mark's Rialto Bridge Day trip to the city of Venice. Our tour will include the Bridge of Sighs, Rialto Bridge, St Mark's Square and Basilica (with Mass celebration). The Basilica contains the body of St Mark the Evangelist, taken here by Venetian merchants in the 9th century. Free afternoon for shopping and sightseeing. In the evening we will take the boat to the mainland. Return to Jesolo. Dinner at the hotel.

Day Four, Saturday

Padua, St. Anthony's Basilica

Padua is one of the most important pilgrimage destinations in Italy. Millions of pilgrims every year make their way to St Anthony's Basilica, where the Franciscan saint, St. Anthony from Lisbon, is buried. Relics include the tongue of the saint, symbol of his outstanding preaching skills. Our visit to the Basilica will include the tomb of St Anthony and the Chapel of the **Relics.** Free time for personal prayer and lunch. Return to Lido di Jesolo in the mid-afternoon. Dinner at the hotel.

Day Five, Sunday

At 10am we will go by coach to Treviso (1 hour drive). This medieval city has beautiful palaces and squares and many historical churches. It is headquarters to many famous Italian businesses such as Benetton, Sisley, Stefanel, Geox, Diadora, DeLonghi and others. Once under the dominion of Venice, the city is embellished with impressive city walls, gates and canals. Mass in the Cathedral of St Peter. Free time for lunch. Return to Lido di Jesolo in the mid-afternoon. Dinner at hotel.

Day Six, Monday

After breakfast we will go by coach to the port and take a boat to the picturesque island of Burano. This is the most colourful island in the Venetian lagoon and is famous for lace making. The tomb of Roman martyr, St Barbara, is conserved here. Mass celebration. Free time for lunch and shopping. Return to the hotel in the late afternoon. Dinner.
