SAMPLE PROGRAMME

Our itinerary aims to include the following.
 Please note that some places may have to be omitted to suit circumstances.

- The Basilicas and tombs of St Francis and St Clare in Assisi. Mass will be celebrated in the basilica of St Francis.
- Mass at the Porziuncola, cradle of the Franciscan order and the place where St Francis died.
- Visit the Duomo of Orvieto and the chapel of the Eucharistic Miracle with its historic frescos commemorating the institution of the feast of Corpus Christi. Mass in the Duomo of Orvieto.
- The “Square of Miracles” in Pisa, including the Duomo, Baptistry and Leaning Tower from outside. Mass in the Duomo of Pisa.
- The major sights of Florence, including the Duomo, Palazzo Vecchio and Ponte Vecchio.
- View the great statues of Florence’s Golden Age in Piazza dei Signori.
- Mass in the principal Marian sanctuary of Florence, La Santissima Annunziata, and visit to the miraculous picture of Our Lady.
- The church and tomb of St Frediano in Lucca, founded by Irish bishop, St Frediano.
- Visit the incorrupt body of St Zita, patroness of Lucca.
- View the beautiful Madonna and Child by Andrea della Robbia in the church of St Michael Archangel, Lucca.
- Mass at the tomb of St Gemma Galgani, mystic and stigmatic.
- Mass in the Basilica of the Assumption Montecatini Terme.
