## Day One, Wednesday

### Arrival in Italy

Early morning flight with Aer Lingus direct to Venice. One hour transfer to 4-star spa resort hotel in Abano Terme near Padua, where we will stay for six nights half board. Orientation tour in the afternoon followed by dinner and overnight.

## Day Two, Thursday

### Day at leisure

Day at leisure. The hotel has the renowned thermal waters of Abano in its indoor and outdoor pools. Dinner.

## Day Three, Friday

### Bologna

Bologna is one of the most beautiful and historic cities of Italy. Our walking tour will include Piazza Maggiore, centre of the city's social life since ancient times. The **Fountain of Neptune** was created by Giambologna in the 16th century. The square is surrounded by historic buildings such as the **Basilica of San Petronio**, patron of Bologna. Built between 1390 and 1663, it is one of the most majestic examples of Italian Gothic. A feature of the historic centre of Bologna is the miles of porticoes that line the streets. These offer shelter from rain and sun, creating the perfect environment for walking and sightseeing. We will see some of the buildings of the University of Bologna, founded in 1088 and the oldest in Europe. Free time for lunch. Return to hotel in late afternoon. Dinner at the hotel.

## Day Four, Saturday

### Free day

Free morning to enjoy the spa in our hotel and shopping in the area. Day at leisure. Dinner at the hotel.

## Day Five, Sunday

### Padua, St. Anthony's Basilica

Today we will visit a top pilgrimage destination in Italy, **Padua**. Millions of pilgrims every year make their way to St Anthony's Basilica, where the Franciscan saint, St. Anthony from Lisbon, is buried. Relics include the tongue of the saint, symbol of his outstanding preaching skills. Opportunity to attend Mass. Tour of the Basilica including artistic masterpieces by Donatello, Altichiero da Zevio, and more. Return to the hotel in the afternoon. Dinner at the hotel.

## Day Six, Monday

### Venice, St Mark's, San Salvador, Rialto Bridge

Day trip to the city of **Venice**. Our tour will include the **Bridge of Sighs, Rialto Bridge, St Mark's Square and Basilica**. The Basilica contains the body of St Mark, taken here by Venetian merchants in the 9<sup>th</sup> century. Visit the church of San Salvador at Rialto Bridge with masterpieces by Titian and others. Afternoon free for shopping and sightseeing. Option of going on gondolas for those interested. In the evening, we will take the boat to the mainland. Return to Abano. Dinner at the hotel.

## Day Seven, Tuesday

### Departure

Check out from our hotel. Transfer to Venice airport. Check in for our Aer Lingus flight to Dublin.
