### SAMPLE ITINERARY

#### Day One, Thursday October 8<sup>th</sup>

#### *Arrival in Nice*

Check in at Dublin airport for our Aer Lingus flight to Nice airport (flight times to be confirmed later). On arrival, we will be taken by coach to our four-star hotel in Sanremo, Italy. The journey follows the coastline and gives us glimpses of some historic towns in France and Italy, such as Menton (last town in France) and Ventimiglia (the first town on the Italian side). Check-in at our hotel. Free time, followed by an orientation tour on foot of the city centre. The promenade which begins outside our hotel is one of the most famous in Italy and is lined by the grand hotels of the 1800s. Dinner at the hotel and overnight.

#### Day Two, Friday October 9<sup>th</sup>

#### *Sanremo*

Today we will have a relaxing day visiting the principal sights of Sanremo, including the ancient basilica of San Siro, the famous casino, the Capuchin friary and other sights in the historic centre. Via Giacomo Matteotti is the main street of the city and is lined with shops, cafes and restaurants. Mass in the Friary. Free afternoon. Dinner at the hotel.

#### Day Three, Saturday October 10<sup>th</sup>

#### *Market in Sanremo*

Day at leisure in Sanremo. The Saturday market in the town centre is renowned throughout Italy. Free afternoon. Mass will be arranged today (and on all other days). Dinner at the hotel

#### Day Four, Sunday October 11<sup>th</sup>

#### *Monaco and Nice*

Coach trip after breakfast to Monaco (1 hour drive). The principality is one of the most exclusive holiday destinations in the world. Our visit will include the cathedral of the Immaculate Conception in Monaco-Ville where Grace Kelly is buried (celebration of Mass), the Prince's Palace (view from outside) the port area and casino, and other sights. There is a beautiful public park in front of the cathedral with fine views of the coastline. We will spend the afternoon in nearby Nice, one of the most-visited cities in France. Once the winter resort of European aristocracy, it is a very multi-cultural place. The Promenade des Anglais ("Promenade of the English") lies along the Bay of the Angels, an area inhabited by wealthy English people in the 18<sup>th</sup> century. We will visit the Cathedral of Nice, originally consecrated in the 11<sup>th</sup> century and rebuilt in the 1600s. The enormous Place Masséna is the main square of the city and is surrounded by beautiful buildings. Dinner in the hotel.

#### Day Five, Monday October 12<sup>th</sup>

#### *Menton*

Today we will visit the last town on the French side of the border, Menton. This was the favourite holiday spot of Queen Victoria and has a monument in her honour. The town is situated on a beautiful stretch of coastline and has a historic church dedicated to St Michael the Archangel. Return to Sanremo in the mid-afternoon. Dinner at the hotel.

#### Day Six, Tuesday October 13<sup>th</sup>

#### *Day at leisure, Market in Sanremo, Our Lady of the Coast*

Day at leisure. On Tuesdays there is a very good market in the town centre. Free afternoon. Optional hike for those interested to the shrine of Our Lady of the Coast above the town. Dinner at the hotel.

#### Day Seven, Wednesday October 14<sup>th</sup>

#### *Departure*

Breakfast and check out. Drive to Nice airport for our flight to Dublin. Flight times to be confirmed.
