Pilgrimage Highlights

A pilgrimage through the heart of Italy.

Assisi (and environs) and Rome offer a remarkable array of important pilgrimage and cultural sites. Our itinerary tries to include a manageable amount of these inspiring places. **This itinerary is not wheelchair/scooter accessible** and does involve a good amount of walking.

Assisi

Walk in the footsteps of St. Francis and St. Clare:

- Visit the historic **Basilicas of St. Francis and St. Clare**, containing the tombs of these saints and many examples of sacred art.
- Mass at the tomb of **Blessed Carlo Acutis**, the young saint who has begun to inspire many hearts around the world.
- Enter the **Porziuncola**, the humble chapel where the Franciscan movement began and where St. Francis died — located inside the grand **Basilica of St. Mary of the Angels**.

Cascia

We will contemplate the life and legacy of **St. Rita**, a woman of deep faith who journeyed from wife and mother to Augustinian nun. Her **shrine and monastery** are one of central Italy's most visited pilgrimage sites.

Loreto

Visiting the Basilica of **Our Lady of Loreto**.

- Believed to house the Holy House of Nazareth, where the Virgin Mary lived and received the Annunciation from the Angel Gabriel
- One of the most important and ancient Marian sites in the Catholic world
- The Holy Family would have lived in this house after their return from Egypt

Rome by Night

An enjoyable way to get an overview of some of the wonders of the Eternal City:

- A panoramic night tour featuring the **Colosseum, Vatican City, St. Peter's Basilica, Tiber Island**, the historic **Jewish Ghetto, St. Mary Major, St. John Lateran**, the **Holy Stairs**, and more.
